



Vincent Carragher

Vincent has been monitoring and lowering the resource use, and the related carbon dioxide emissions, of communities for over 10 years. Currently his monitoring and research has facilitated, trained and engaged 57 communities directly and a further 70 indirectly. The majority of the communities he has worked with are mostly based in the counties of North Tipperary, South Tipperary, Limerick and Clare. As part of this work he developed and implemented a project which facilitated, trained and enabled the community of Ballina (Tipperary) to reduce its emissions by 28% over four years.

In TEA he has worked on IEE and Interreg projects including; Energy Neighbourhoods I and II, SERVE, ECCC, ACE, Trainenergy, Cleandrive, Mobilise Energy Awareness and BioNett. In 2011 he completed his doctorate research study in the Centre for Environmental Research in University of Limerick.
